Following a delicious pot luck supper, President Tom Platis called the November TAWGS meeting to order with self introductions. Mary Pat Fischer moved and Bob Saathoff seconded that the October minutes be approved as printed in the Lily Pad. Motion carried.

Treasurer Jim Green reported that we have \$2,761.60 in the checking account and \$1,148.60 in the saving account for a grand total of \$3,910.20.

There was no unfinished business.

Bob Saathoff reported on the exhibit for the 2006 Lawn and Garden Show. He said that there will be two water gardens to be connected by a bridge. We will be working with the Topeka Beautification Association and the Shawnee Parks and Recreation and will have a much larger booth area this year. Jim Green moved that we authorize Bob to spend up to \$1,200 on the Lawn and Garden Show. Mary Pat Fischer seconded the motion, which carried.

President Tom Platis announced the new officers for 2006 and presented the gavel to the new President Duane Eberhardt. Other officers are Vice President Floyd Gruver, Secretary Diane Gruver and Treasurer Jim Green.

Floyd Gruver presented outgoing president Tom Platis a plaque for his dedication and service as president for the last three years.

Meeting adjourned. The next meeting will be February 15, 2006.


